
Kuusisto & Djokic in Concert

Canadian-born Denise Djokic is well-known and loved in Ottawa. She has been a guest performer in music festivals in Ottawa, and has performed with many Canadian and international orchestras. She has earned world -wide acclaim for her sincere, powerful interpretations and "arrestingly beautiful tone colour" (The Strad). Denise is a frequent guest of the Jupiter Quartet and Boston Trio. Her repertoire is impressive and includes the works of Bach, Bartok, Beethoven, Mendelssohn, Prokofiev, Mozart and Brahms, among others.





Pekka Kuusisto stepped onto the international scene at the young age of nineteen, upon winning the prestigious Sibelius Violin competition in 1995.
